The Comparative Enrolment and Application Report was distributed at the table and highlighted (a copy is attached to these minutes).

c) 2009-2010 Budget

The 2009/2010 draft budget summary attached to the agenda was presented and a current budget shortfall of \$2.6M was reported. Mitigation strategies were presented and there was agreement to expedite the section confirmation process to clarify sections offered to achieve increased enrolment. Enhancements will be revisited once additional budget information becomes available near the end of February.

d) Strategic Planning Update

A consultant has been retained to facilitate the College's Strategic Planning process and employees will be provided an opportunity to participate in this process in the upcoming weeks. A draft strategic plan should be available in May or June with a final launch in the fall.
