## A) FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT & BUSINESS COMPUTER

#### a) New Course

i) FGMT 2500 – Personal Financial Planning 2

This course has been developed as a capstone for the new Financial Services Diploma program. Students will examine advanced personal financial planning topics with a focus on professional skills development for a career in the financial services sector. Prerequisites include FMGT 2116, and CMNS 1118 or ENGL 1127. FMGT 2325 and BUSM 1500 are



suggested but not required. The course will be launched in the 201810 semester.

i) Delete redundant note in HSCI program curriculum

Students can apply directly to the Health Sciences programs, so there is no need for a formal declaration as described in this note.
