6. POLICY

A) POLICY REVISION

a) F1001 – Regular Studies Credentials and Micro-Credentials

The proposal increases the residency requirement from 40% to 50% for Baccalaureate and Associate degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates, and removes the restriction for these credentials that prevents students from using transfer credit in the final 40% of the program.

IT WAS MOVED by W Pierson, seconded by E Barbeau, that the revised *Policy F1001 – Regular Studies Credentials and Micro-Credentials* be approved by Education Council. Some minor amendments were made in the documents to improve clarity.
