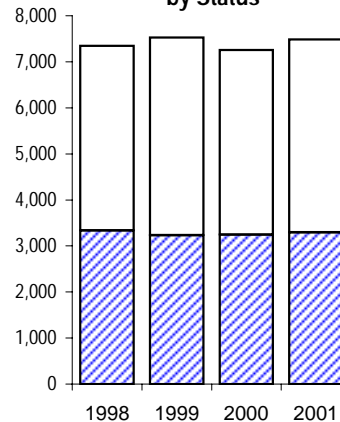

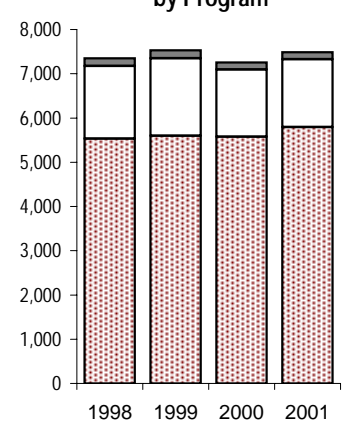

Headcount Enrolments by Program

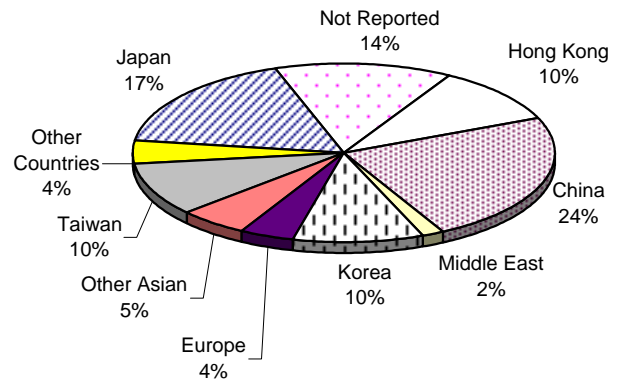

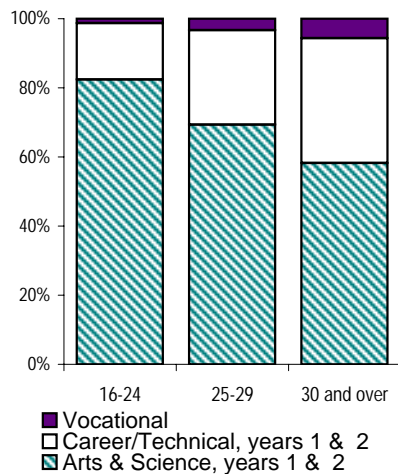

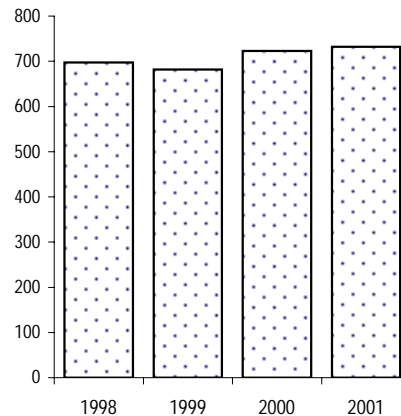
