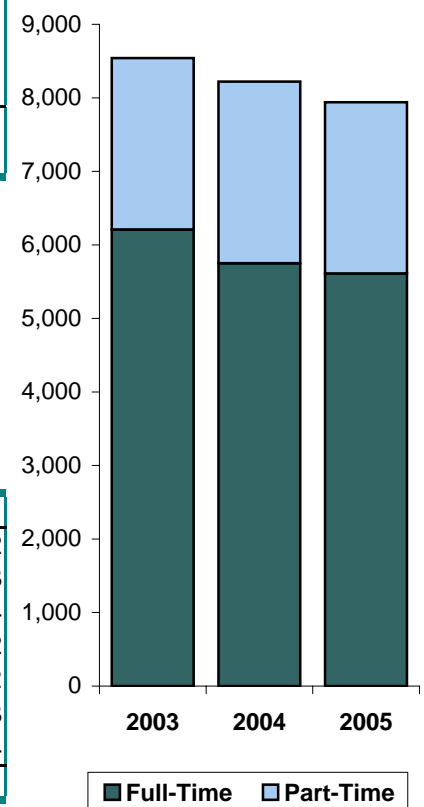

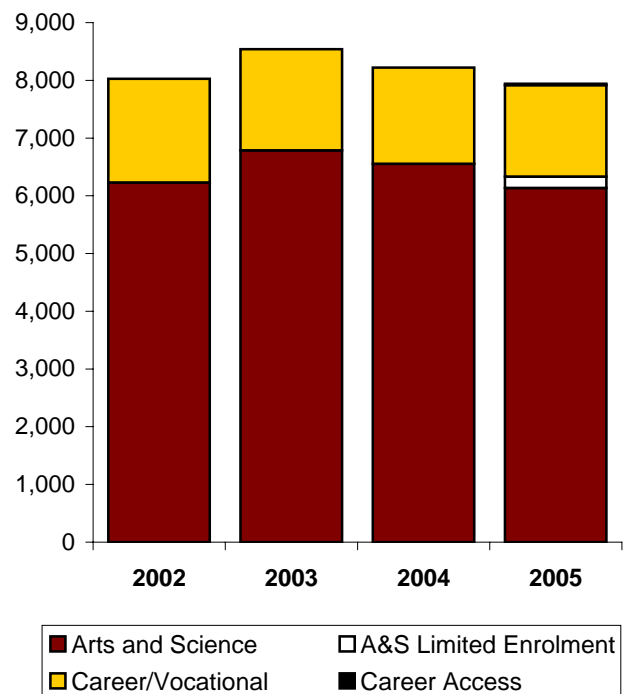

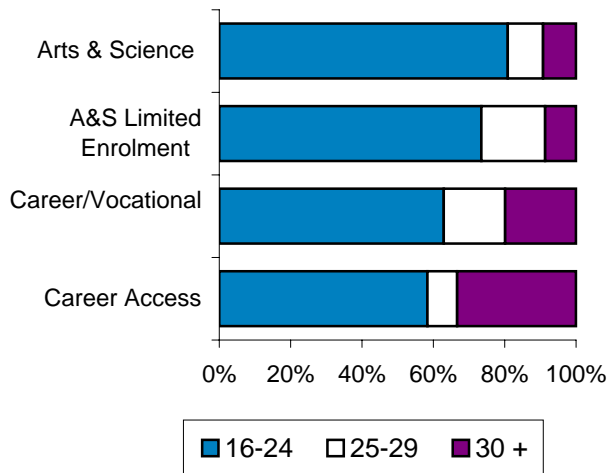

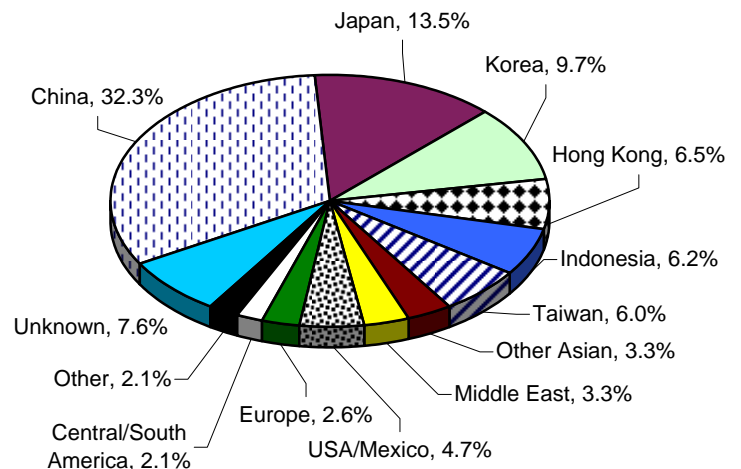

International Students by Country of Origin (credit programs only) n=569

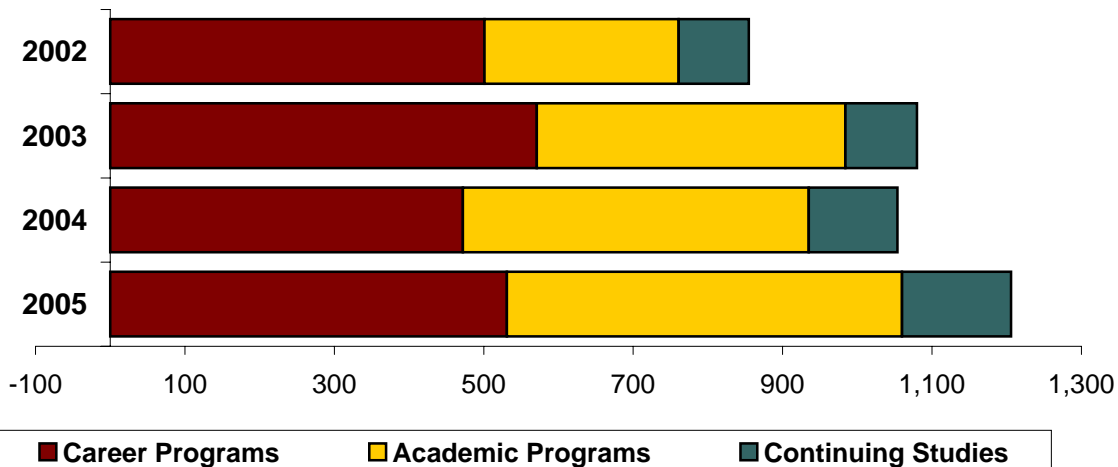
