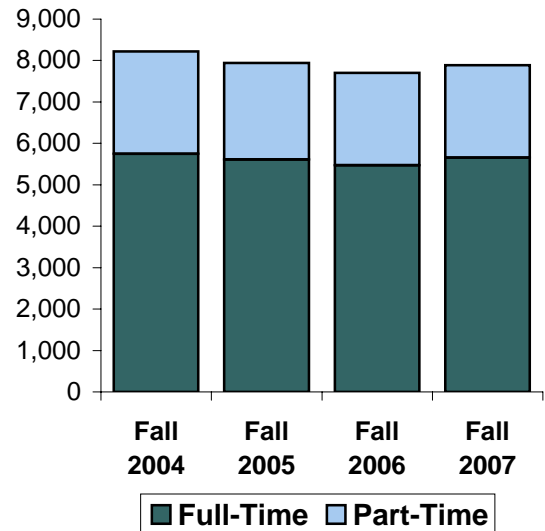

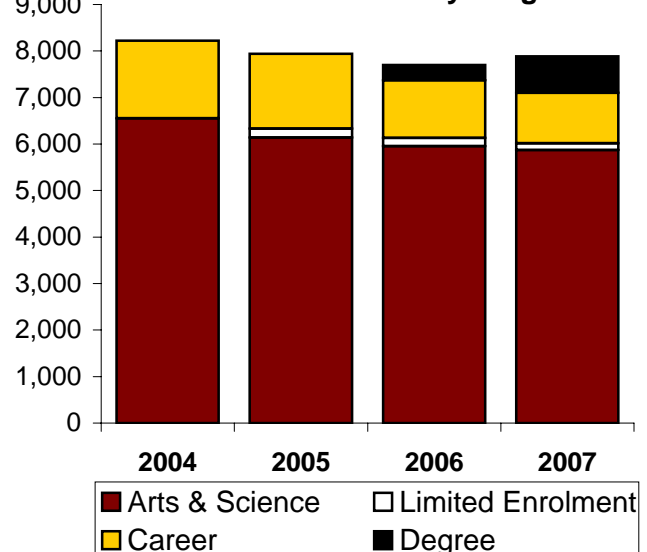

Headcount Enrolment by Program



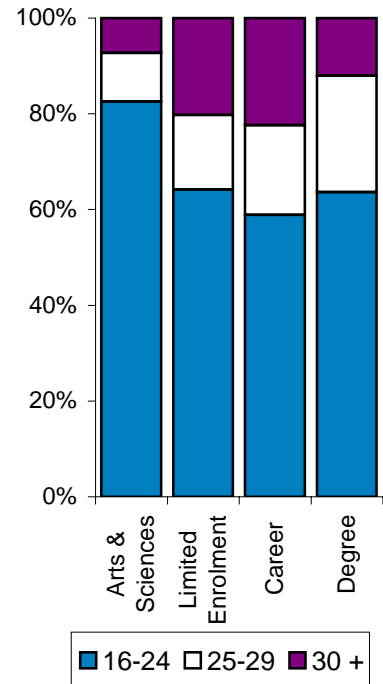

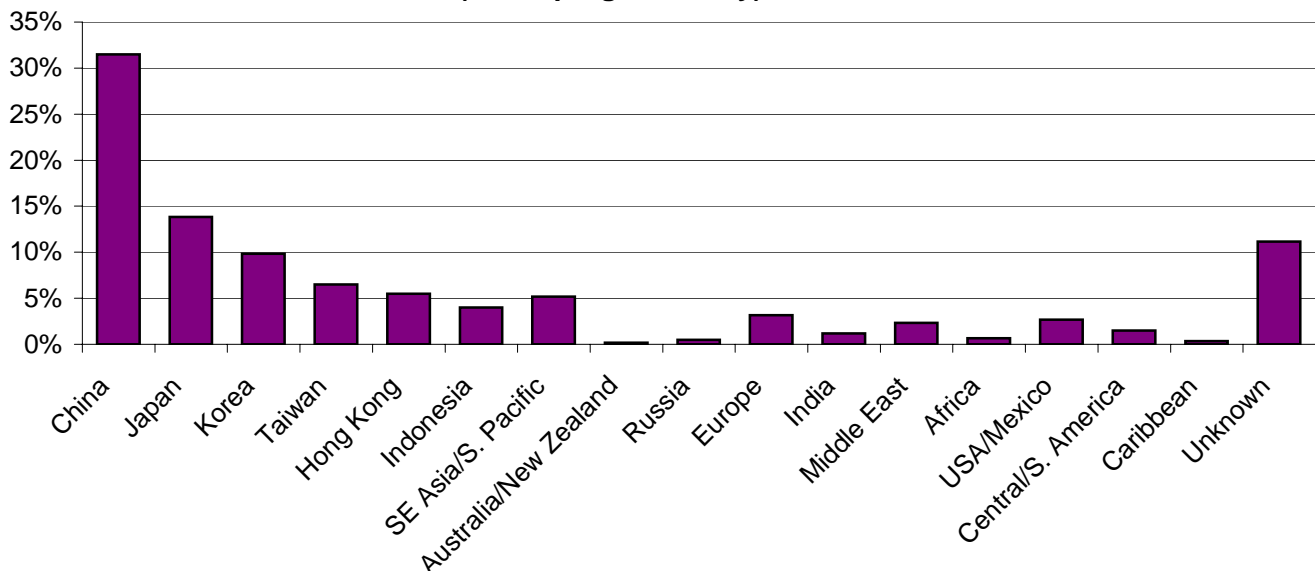
Age Distribution of Langara Students

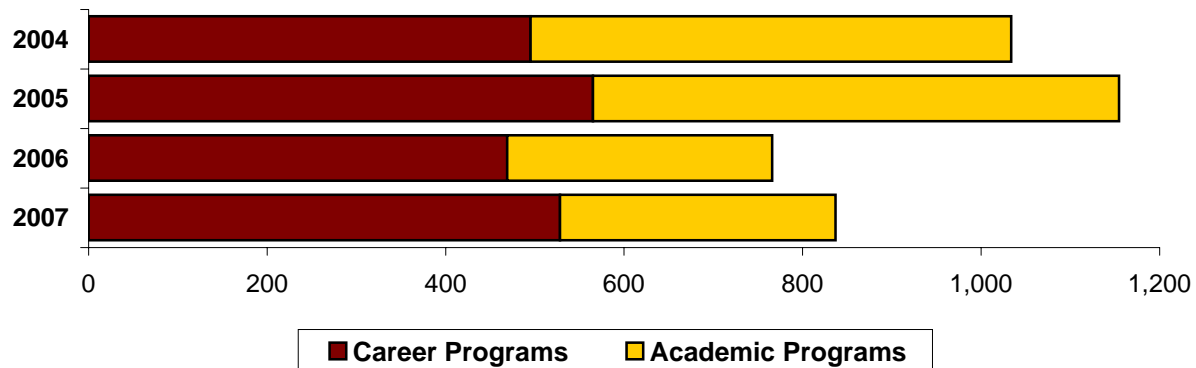
