Blue box – The unique CRN number denotes each individual course. In the example above, there are two separate course offerings of Bookkeeping 1.

Red box – A single course offering may have multiple rows outlining its schedule. The red box above shows a single course of online Bookkeeping 1 with two rows of schedule information.

Orange box – “1 eve We” means one evening on Wednesday. “7 eve We” means seven evenings on Wednesdays.

Yellow box – “Online” without a time range next to it means the course is [online Asynchronous](#), which means the course does not have scheduled class time, is mostly self-paced, but has set dates for quizzes, assignments, exams, etc. “1830-2130 Online” is the final exam for the online course. However, please disregard the “online” part as all final exams is held in-person on main campus, with the only exception for those students who reside outside of Metro Vancouver (and such students should refer to [Proctored Exam page](#) for more directions).

Green box – Indicates the delivery mode of the course. In-person course is noted by “Main campus”, and online course is noted by “Online”. Please note that there are two types of Online courses in the program – [Asynchronous](#) and [Synchronous](#).

CRN 50079 is an Online Asynchronous Bookkeeping 1 course, with in-person final exam on February 21st from 18:30-21:30. CRN 50078 is an in-person Bookkeeping 1 course that will run for seven Wednesday evenings from 18:30-21:30 starting January 10th.
