Student Behaviour

While the focus of the camps is on fun and learning, there are some behavioural expectations for attendees of the camps to ensure everyone receives an enjoyable experience. Student behaviour during the summer camps should be much the same as during their regular school year, in that students should act with courtesy and civility while being encouraged to interact with each other and have some fun. Students are expected to show up on time, not be late or leave early on a routine basis, and be willing to fully participate in Summer Camp(s).

To ensure the safety of all Summer Camp participants: physical violence, harassment, bullying or racism will not be tolerated. Parents/guardians will be notified if their child's behaviour is inappropriate. If such inappropriate behaviour continues, Langara College reserves the right to remove the child from the Camp and to refuse any further participation. No money will be refunded.

If a student is not enjoying the camps, is not able to participate in a collegial and friendly manner, or is not willing to behave in a way that means other students are impacted by their behaviour, the parents will be notified. Every attempt will be made to keep a participant in a summer camp but, should the behaviour continue, Langara College reserves the right to remove the student from the camp.

Students should refrain from swearing, using offensive or degrading language, not be confrontational with others, engage in meaningful dialogue in class and not try to "hijack" the class for personal benefit, show respect for other points of view, and not harass or bully any other students or the instructor.

The use of cell phones, laptops, tablets, and other electronic devices is not permitted in a classroom or computer lab.

Food and drinks are not allowed in the computer labs.

Langara College computers and internet are for academic use only, students may not access personal accounts, or search for topics or subjects on Langara computers outside of what an instructor has asked for.

While students have fun and enjoy the camp experience, there should not be a disregard for the safety and well-being of others – no pushing, shoving, fake tripping or general horseplay.

Assumption of Risk and Consent

I, the undersigned, the Parent/Guardian of _____ do hereby consent to her/his participation in the Langara College Summer Camp(s) and related activities. I understand that the Langara Summer Camps are designed to help teens explore their creative and practical sides in an academic setting and will involve hands-on activities. I understand that the Camps commence at 9.00am each day and end at 3.30pm. Camp staff will not be responsible for my child beyond that time and further understand that the College gym has drop in recreation from 3.30pm to 5.00pm. I further understand that Summer Camp participants will not be supervised during lunch breaks.

I am aware that there are potential risks and hazards associated with my child's participation in the Langara Summer Camp(s). I understand that the hazards include, but are not limited to:

- **CAMPUS:** Navigation in unfamiliar territory; becoming lost or separated from their group; congestion; slips, trips or falls; hallways; stairs; outside space: lawns, trees, ponds.
- **CAFETERIA:** large groups moving through a confined area; spilled drinks or food; coffee urns; hot water dispensers, congestion.
- **CLASSROOMS:** electrical cords; equipment, impact with chairs or other potential obstructions.
- **COMPUTER LAB:** electrical cords; equipment, impact with chairs or other potential obstructions.
- **ALLERGIC REACTIONS:** allergic reactions resulting from contact with cultivated or wild plants; food or drinks; spider, tick or insect bites.
- **GAMES OR PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES:** bumps, collisions, falling, tripping, bruises, broken bones, sprains, eye injuries; failure to play safely within one's own ability.
- **WEATHER:** changing weather conditions; wet weather; the effects of heat or strong sunlight.
- **OTHER HAZARDS:** theft of property; the possibility that my child, or others do not heed safety instructions or restrictions given to them; the possibility that my child may be absent from sessions without permission; other camp participants; or other people visiting the same locations as my child; negligence or other Summer Camp participants or Langara College staff.

I acknowledge that accidents may occur during my child's participation in the Langara Summer Camp(s) and can occur without fault on either the part of my child or Langara College. I am aware that Langara College will take all necessary safety precautions and will attempt to minimize any risks associated with Summer Camp activities. Accidents however, may cause loss of personal property, injury or even death.

I acknowledge that if require more information with regard to the activities and/or risks of an individual Summer Camp that I should contact Program Coordinator, Langara College Continuing Studies.

I understand that my child is expected to be respectful and considerate to other participants, Langara College and other people visiting the campus, and must adhere to the rules with regard to student behaviour as set out above. I further understand that inappropriate behaviour on the part of my child may result in her/his removal from the Summer Camp and that I will not receive any refund of fees.

I understand that my child will be solely responsible for her/his personal property and effects during the Summer Camp(s) and acknowledge that it is recommended that valuable items are not brought on to the Langara College campus.
