RBC Foundation donates \$100,000 to support Indigenous Gathering Space programs

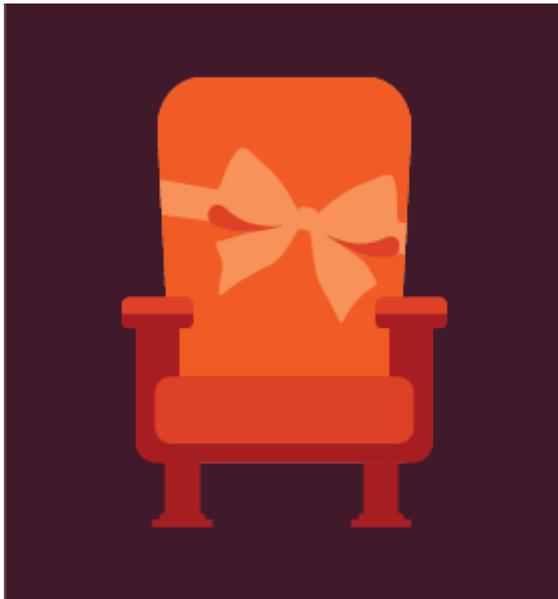
