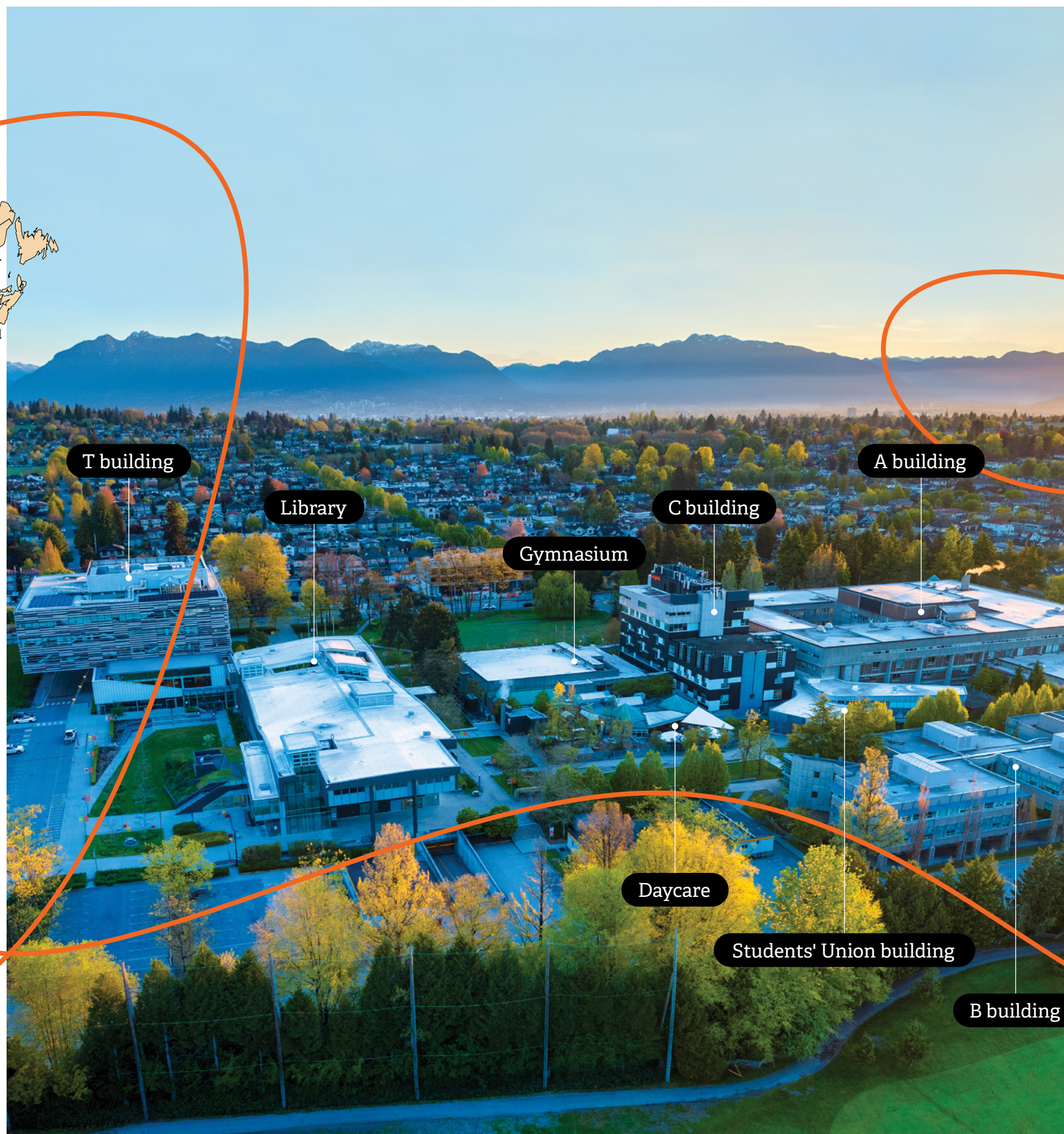

Accessibility Services reduces barriers to learning and participation in our community for students with disabilities.



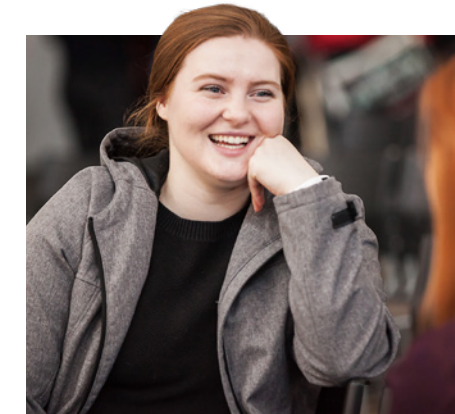

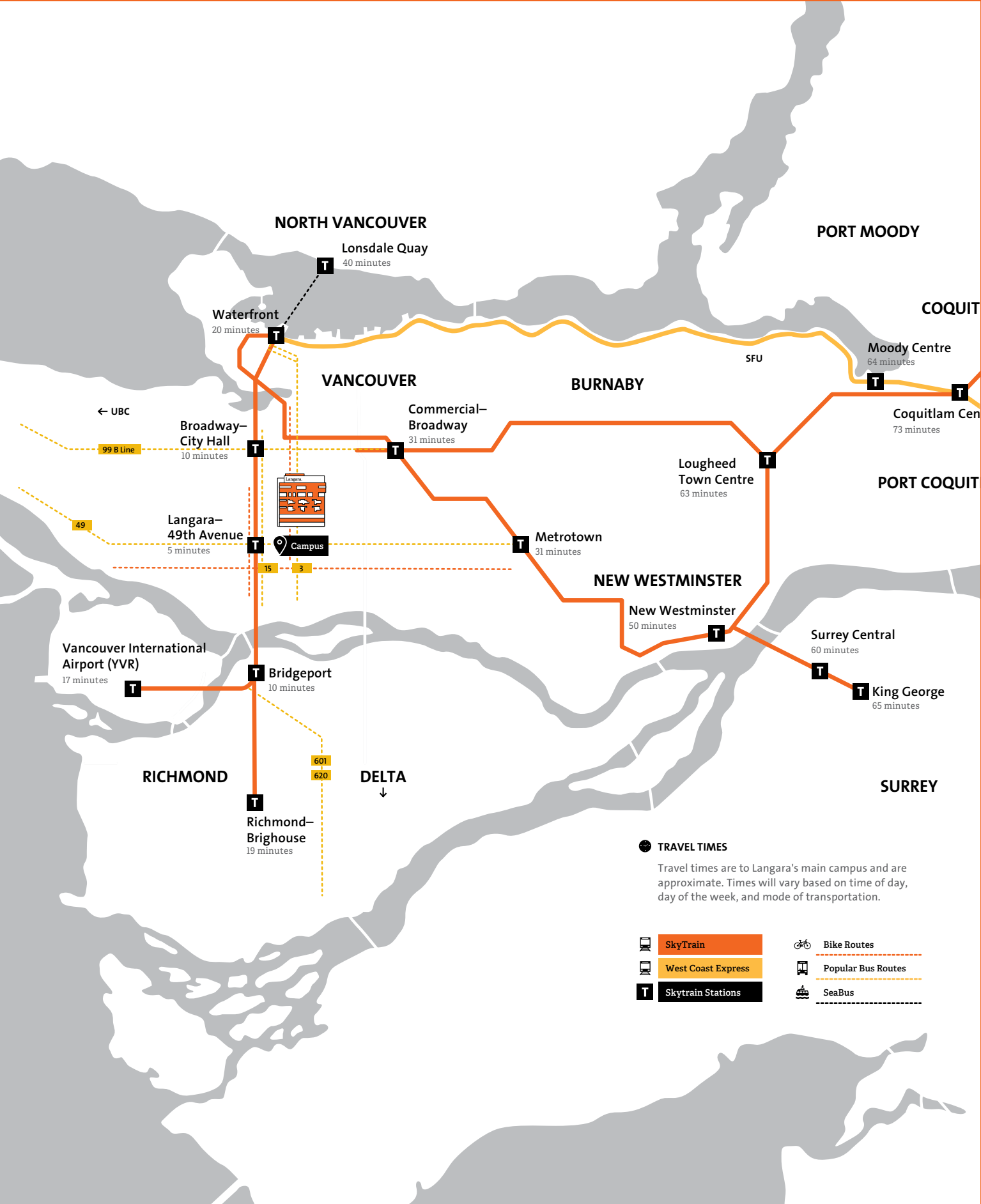
VANCOUVER'S MULTICULTURAL SPIRIT
