

These programs prepare you for career opportunities and help you reach your education goals.


**Open enrolment programs** are open to students who meet general admission requirements and give you the flexibility to explore different subject areas.

### **REGULAR STUDIES**

- 1 CHECK ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
  - General admission requirements
  - English language requirements
  - Additional program requirements
- 2 APPLY
  - Gather your documents in preparation to submit your application.
  - Apply at apply.educationplannerbc.ca/ langara and pay the application fee.
- 3 SUBMIT DOCUMENTS
  - To complete your application, log onto the Langara Student Information System and submit all required documents.
- 4 RECEIVE + ACCEPT YOUR OFFER
  - Langara sends an Offer of Admission by email. Accept your offer promptly.

### **ENTRANCE BURSARIES**

Eligible secondary school students can apply for entrance bursaries which are credited towards the cost of tuition and fees in their first term of study. To learn more and apply, visit langara.ca/entrance-bursaries.

### **APPLICATION DEADLINES**


Regular Studies program applications open 11 months before the start of each semester. Apply early because acceptance and registration times are based on date of application. Spaces are limited and subject to change.

### **CONTINUING STUDIES (CS)**

- 1 CHECK ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
  - Visit Continuing Studies program and course pages online for dates, fees, and applicable prerequisites.
- 2 APPLY
  - If applicable, submit your application package as instructed on the program page and pay the application fee.
- 3 SUBMIT DOCUMENTS
  - Some programs require additional documents. Contact your program coordinator for more information or to check the status of your application.
- 4 RECEIVE + ACCEPT YOUR OFFER
  - Langara sends an Offer of Admission by email. Accept your offer promptly.

Continuing Studies program applications are accepted year-round.

The 49<sup>th</sup> Avenue bus stops at the main campus, while Main Street and Cambie Street buses are only a few blocks away.




**SKYTRAIN**
