1. CALL TO ORDER / WELCOME / ELECTION UPDATE

The meeting was called to order at 1:03 p.m. upon declaration of a quorum. T MacMillan welcomed new members Bhumika Laller and Debbie Schachter.

2. LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

T MacMillan acknowledged the meeting's location on the unceded traditional territory of the Musqueam First People, who have given Langara College the name snəweyət lələm, *house of teachings*.

T MacMillan noted the large quantity of submissions and the thorough review and revisions made by the Curriculum Review Committee.

IT WAS MOVED by S Wiebe, seconded by A Syme, that the new courses *ADAP 1202*, *ADAP 1203*, *ADAP 1204*, *AVEP 1205*, and *AVEP 1206* be approved by Education Council.

L Sifko explained that Langara is exiting its agreement with the Center of Arts and Technology and has redesigned a new program that incorporates advice received during the recent QAPA review. The redesign involves creating new courses and revising existing courses to improve the delivery, structure, and relevance of the curriculum.

IT WAS MOVED by A Sullivan, seconded by S Dane, that the revised courses *ADAP 1301*, *AVEP 1104*, *AVEP 1202*, *SANI 1051* and *SANI 1056* be approved by Education Council.

L Sifko noted that the revisions will better reflect what is being taught and ensure content is relevant to the current industry. All courses are part of the redesigned 2D and 3D Technologies diplomas. In each course, the title has been changed, calendar description and learning outcomes are updated, and hours and CEUs are adjusted.

L Sifko explained that both new courses are adapted from courses used in the original version of the Animation programs with updated content and learning outcomes.

L Sifko noted that name changes reflect how the courses are ladderred throughout the program. With revised course hours, lab and instructional time are better balanced.

As part of the Workday SIS project, the implementation team has identified aspects of CS programs and courses that are not captured in Banner and are being applied by staff in CS or in the CSRO. To ensure that Workday upholds the practices and expectations of the CS program staff, all CS program and course information has been collected in one place to create a single source of truth. The information is not being altered but reflects the current state of each program in the Faculty of Continuing Studies.

IT WAS MOVED by A Sullivan, seconded by A Alves, that the program and course data described in the thirty-one memos from Connie Chong, Dean of Continuing Studies be received for information.

B) EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

a) Temporary/Emergency Change – FOR INFORMATION

i) Citation in Infant and Toddler Care and Education

T MacMillan explained that an emergency change was implemented for this program after it was discovered that an incorrect English Language Requirement had been applied to the admissions criteria which would create a barrier for students who otherwise meet the academic requirements. This temporary correction changed the requirement from Category 2 to Category 3 in time for Summer 2025 registration.

b) Program Change

i) Citation in Infant and Toddler Care and Education

This revision formally corrects the English Language Requirement for admission from Category 2 to Category 3 effective Fall 2025. This change aligns the program with the existing admissions criteria for the Diploma and Certificate in Early Childhood Education programs.

IT WAS MOVED by N Franzova, seconded by P Aroca-Ouellete, that the revised admission requirements for the *Citation in Infant and Toddler Care and Education* be approved by Education Council.

c) Course Change

i) ECED 1119 – Practicum I

The revision adds “submission of a satisfactory Criminal Record Check (CRC)” to the list of prerequisites.

IT WAS MOVED by N Franzova, seconded by S Dane, that the revised prerequisite statement for *ECED 1119 – Practicum I* be approved by Education Council.

A Clark explained that due to coding limitations in Banner, the Criminal Record Check requirement needed to be managed manually; however, it can be formally coded as a prerequisite in the new Workday system and therefore is being added to the prerequisite statement. He also noted that the proposed prerequisite statement includes the phrase “or permission of the department” which does not apply to the Criminal Record Check and this should be clarified. After a request was made for clarification regarding other aspects of the prerequisite statement, it was agreed by consensus that the proposal be withdrawn for further editing.

C) PSYCHOLOGY

a) Course Change

i) PSYC 2321 – Data Analysis for Psychology

The proposal removes the equivalency for PSYC 2321 and STAT 1124. It was decided by the Psychology and Statistics departments that the two courses are not truly equivalent, and students should be eligible to receive credit for both as is the case at other institutions. The proposal also restores the Math Diagnostic Test (MDT) as an alternative to the Statistics Diagnostic Test (SDT) for meeting the math prerequisite for registration in PSYC 2321.

IT WAS MOVED by N Franzova, seconded by P Aroca-Ouellette, that the revisions in *PSYC 2321 – Data Analysis for Psychology* be approved by Education Council.

7. OTHER BUSINESS

A) BLOCK TRANSFER AGREEMENT

a) Memorandum of Understanding between Columbia College and Langara College

The Memorandum describes the agreement for facilitating the admission of students who have completed a set of requirements at Columbia College and successfully completed all bridging courses into Langara College's Bachelor of Science in Bioinformatics program, provided all other entrance criteria are met and space remains available.

IT WAS MOVED by P Aroca-Ouellette, seconded by N Franzova, the *Memorandum of Understanding between Columbia College and Langara College Regarding Admission into Langara BSc in Bioinformatics* be approved by Education Council.

B) BOARD POLICY REVIEW

- Briefing Note
- Policy 400: Vision and Mission

S McGillivray referred to the preview presented at the last Education Council meeting in which Council was invited to provide feedback regarding this Board policy. The current proposal is to repeal the policy as its content is covered by Langara's Strategic Plan and the bylaws of the Board of Governors. In order to maintain relevance, the proposal would make minor amendments to Board By-Laws 201 and 203 in conjunction with the repeal of Policy 400. These amendments were presented to Education Council for feedback.

During discussion, concerns were expressed regarding the proposed phrasing for Section 7.1 of Board By-Law 203 *Powers, Duties and Benefits of President and CEO* in which the President's powers and duties to "oversee the development and execution of the College's strategic priorities" would become "develop the College's strategic plans..." and that the proposed revision would affect the role of the Board of Governors in establishing performance targets.

It was recommended that the proposed changes be channeled through the full policy review process with feedback invited from the broader College community. S McGillivray agreed to return the proposal for further consultation.

B) ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
