





 Career Studies, and Continuing Studies programs, and courses.



CONTINUING STUDIES AND LEAP STUDENTS

This is intended for students in a Continuing Studies program or LEAP only.

Upon arrival, you will need to apply for Medical Services Plan (MSP) as it is mandatory in the province of British Columbia (BC) for international students to have medical insurance. Since BC MSP does not begin until 3 months after your arrival, you will need to purchase private insurance for those first 3 months. Once your travel arrangements are made, buy the insurance to begin on your first day in BC, for 3 months. To begin, click on the "Apply for Insurance" icon below.

If you are in a Regular Studies program, please refer to the Returning Regular Studies Students or Early Arrivals pages to purchase your insurance or for more information. Do not purchase insurance from this page.

Prepare for arrival

How early you can arrive before start studying?

- There is no set time frame for you to arrive in Canada before you begin your studies.
- You should give yourself a reasonable amount of time to prepare before you start studying.

Arriving in Canada

- At arrival, a Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) officer will check your travel documents and reasons for visiting Canada.
- Answer honestly and ask for an interpreter if needed.
- ☐ If you are coming with an eTA: It's electronically linked to your passport and it is usually valid for 5 years or until your passport expires, whichever comes first
- ☐ If you are coming with a visa: This is a physical sticker in your passport.
- ☐ If you are coming with a Letter of Introduction: The officer will issue you a study permit at the border, with conditions on the permit if applicable.

Documentation

Primary documents:

- √ Valid Passport
- ✓ Temporary Resident Visa or eTA
- ✓ Letter of Introduction from IRCC
- ✓ Original copy of your LOA Letter of Acceptance from Langara (print from your email)

Documentation

Secondary documents:

- ✓ Course registration information
- ✓ Flight booking tickets
- ✓ Accommodation information
- ✓ Important contacts
- ✓ Driver's license
- ✓ Proof of immunization, if any
- ✓ Photocopies of important documents, such as: birth certificate, previous education documents, family member documents, etc.



Documentation

Other things the officer may ask:

- ✓ Where you will stay
- ✓ Will leave Canada by the end of your visit
- ✓ Evidence of Funds
- ✓ Have ties with home country
- ✓ Be in good health and have health insurance.
- ✓ Have no criminal or immigration convictions



Study Permit Compliance

As a study permit holder, you must:

- Ensure that your study permit is valid for the entire length of your program.
- You may apply to extend your study permit.
 - Extend your study permit at least 3-4 months before it expires
- If your passport will expire in Canada, renew it at least 6 months before the expiry date.

OR



Your application for an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) has been approved. You are now authorized to travel to Canada by air.

When you travel to Canada, you will need to bring the passport you used to apply for your eTA, as the eTA is electronically linked to it. Should you obtain a new passport, you will need to apply for a new eTA Airline check-in staff and the Canada Border Services Agency will have electronic access to your eTA stratus using your massport.

the future, you can verify the status and expiration of your eTA by using the eTA Check Status Tool. do this, you will need the eTA number noted above and details from the passport you used to apply your eTA.

Post-Arrival

Social Insurance Number (SIN)



- It is a 9-digit number that you need to work in Canada or to have access to government programs and benefits.
- Apply <u>online</u> or visit a Service Canada office

Banking and money management




- There are many bank institutions in Canada.
- Many of them have special offers and accounts for International Students.
- Budgeting is important as there are a number of fixed costs, including:
 - Tuition
 - Accommodation
 - Transportation (car or transit)
 - o Food
 - Cell phone
 - Medical insurance
 - Daily necessities
