Biometrics- you will need to provide biometrics (fingerprints and photo) if you are submitting a study permit extension, work permit extension, Post Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) application, co-op work permit, or Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) application.

- If you have provided biometrics in the last 10 years, they are still valid and you will not need to submit again.

How to apply for Biometrics (fingerprints and photo):

- Obtain a Confirmation of Enrolment Letter from the Registrar's office.
- Pay biometric fee when you submit your online application.
- Individual Fee: \$85 🛛 Family: up to \$170
- After paying the fees, you will receive an **Instruction Letter** confirming that you need to give your biometric information and where you can go to do this.
- YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE INSTRUCTION LETTER AS WELL AS A VALID PASSPORT when you go to give your Biometrics.
- You must provide Biometric information within 30 days of the receipt of Instruction Letter.
- **GO TO AN OFFICIAL BIOMETRICS COLLECTION SERVICE POINT-** Biometrics must be given in person.

- Before you go to give Biometrics, you must make an appointment through the **SERVICE CANADA APPOINTMENT SYSTEM.**
