

Extend Your Study Permit

The expiry date on your study permit indicates when you must stop studying. This date may be based on the length of your:

- program, plus 90 extra days
- pre-requisite courses, plus 90 extra days or
- passport validity, minus 30 days, if your passport expires before you complete your studies

The extra 90 days allow you time to prepare to leave Canada or to [apply to extend your status in Canada](#).

When to extend your study permit

You are advised to extend your study permit **a months before it expires**. The expiry date is located on the top right corner of your study permit. You cannot extend your study permit beyond the expiry date on your passport.

Maintained Status

If your study permit expires **after you have submitted your application for an extension, but before a decision is made, on your application, you may remain in** Canada under maintained status.

While on maintained Status:

- You are legally considered a temporary resident.
- You must remain in Canada
- You must continue to meet the conditions of the original study permit

If you leave Canada while on maintained status, you will **lose this status** and must wait for approval of your new study permit before resuming studies upon re-entry.

If your Study Permit has expired

You have lost your status if you are still in Canada and:

- Your study permit expires before you apply for.:
 - a new study permit
- You did not comply with the conditions of your study permit.

In some cases, you may be eligible to apply to RESTORE your status as a student.

Restoration of Status

In some cases, you may be eligible to apply to RESTORE your status as a student. To apply you must:

- Submit your application within 90 days of losing your status
- Continue to meet the requirements of your stay
- Have complied with all conditions of your previous permit
- Pay your fees
 - restoration (\$246.25.75) and
 - study permit (\$150)

For Restoration, under section select both:
 - **An initial study permit or extension of study permit, and**
 - **Restoration of temporary resident status as a student**
3. Instruction Guide for application **IMM5552**

Document List

- Photocopies of passport pages
- Photocopy of your current immigration document
- Confirmation of Study Permit Extension Letter
- PAL or PAL Exemption Letter
- Proof of funds available or means of financial support
- Digital photo (passport size photo)

Step 4

You must pay the Study Permit Extension fee (\$150)

If you are restoring your status as a student you must pay the Restoration fee (\$389.75)
