

Inviting Friends or Family to Canada

You may invite your family or friends to visit you as long as you have valid legal status in Canada. If the person you are inviting requires a Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) to enter Canada, they must apply for it from their home country or at a Canadian Embassy, Consulate or High Commission office in their home country.

Application Steps

1. Request a Confirmation of Enrollment Letter
2. If graduating request Grad letter for Inviting Parents to Convocation
3. Write a Letter of Invitation
4. Send your documents to the person you are inviting

Supporting Documents: for yourself

- Copy of documents proving your status in Canada (i.e.: study permit or work permit)
- Copy of Passport
- Letter of Invitation (written by you)
- Confirmation of Enrollment Letter
- Grad letter for Inviting Parents to Convocation (if needed)
- Letter from your employer confirming your job (if applicable)
- Proof of financial funds

Supporting Documents: of the person you are inviting

- Proof of financial funds
- Proof of economic and social ties to their home country
- Proof of return to home country
- Travel history

Economic ties: bank statements, investments, employment letters, business ownership, proof of property

Social ties: evidence that family members back home are dependent on them for financial/other support, proof that they must return home after their visit
