

Part time student loans

Apply

- Paper application obtained at studentaidbc.ca or Registrar and Enrolment Services
- Register for 3-8 credits (3-6 credits for students with permanent disabilities)
- Complete the form and hand into Registrar and Enrolment Services

Welcome Email

- A welcome email to complete your Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement (MSFAA) from National Student Loans will be emailed to you

Notice of Assessment

- Notice on how much funding you will receive broken down between loans and grants
- This Notice of Assessment letter will arrive by Canada Post to your home and it will have a MSFAA number to use to set up your National Student Loans account

National Student Loans

- Register for a new account on nslsc.ca
- Set up your Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement (MSFAA) with the information from the welcome email and your Notice of Assessment
- Provide National Student Loans with your direct deposit bank account numbers

Confirmation of Enrolment

- Langara will confirm your enrolment after you complete your MSFAA
- Students must remain enrolled and successfully pass all the of credits that you received funding

Disbursement of Your Funds

- Direct deposit into your bank account within 7 days from the first day of class
- If you applied after classes start, direct deposit within 3 weeks from the Confirmation of Enrolment date
- If you have tuition owing to Langara, it will be sent to Langara within 5 weeks from the Confirmation of Enrolment date.

Full time student loans

Apply

- Complete the online application at studentaidbc.ca (you can do this before you register for classes)
- Register for 9 or more credits (6 or more credits for students with permanent disabilities)

First Time Applying

- Register for a new account on studentaidbc.ca
- Verify your ID with your BC Services Card:
 - By video chat by downloading the BC Services Card App
 - OR**
 - In person at a Service BC Office
- Return to studentaidbc.ca to complete your application
- Print, sign, mail your declaration (and parent's or spouse's declaration if applicable)

Subsequent Application

- Log into your studentaidbc.ca dashboard
- Complete the online application

Notice of Assessment

- Notice on how much funding you will receive broken down between loans and grants
- This will be mailed to your address and displayed on your StudentAid BC dashboard

First Time with National Student Loans

- Register for a new account on nslsc.ca
- Set up your electronic Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement (eMSFAA)
- Provide National Student Loans with your direct deposit bank account numbers

Subsequent National Student Loans

- Verify your direct deposit bank account numbers are still current

Confirmation of Enrolment

- Langara will automatically confirm your enrolment starting 10 calendar days before the first day of class and will continue to confirm nightly for students who apply late until 6 weeks before the term ends (Apr 30, Aug 31, Dec 31). Students must be registered in 9 or more student loan eligible credits to receive funds (6 or more credits for students with permanent disabilities)

Disbursement of Your Funds

- Direct deposit into your bank account within 7 days from the first day of class
- If you applied late, direct deposit within 3 weeks from the Confirmation of Enrolment date

Disbursement if Tuition Owing to Langara

- Will be sent to Langara within 5 weeks from the Confirmation of Enrolment date
- If you added courses after the Confirmation of Enrolment date, you have to pay the difference
